

NINEBARK TREE FORMS

Physocarpus opulifolius

Centerglow

Much like 'Diablo' except the red color is far brighter and new foliage emerges a glowing yellow-green. Blooms in spring with creamy-white flowers. A bold array of colors that lends excitement to the shrub border all season long.



Diablo

Selected for the intense reddish purple foliage on upright, arching branches. Added contrast to the dark foliage are summer's clusters of creamy-white flowers. Tree forms are own root and very hardy.



Summer Wine

An improved ninebark, with neat compact branching and fine cut dark crimson-red leaves. Easily grown in average, dry to medium moisture, well-drained soil in full sun to part shade. Tolerates a wide range of soil conditions. Small pinkish-white, five-petaled flowers in dense, flat, rounded clusters appear in late spring.
