SORBARIA

Sorbaria sorbifolia

ASH LEAF SPIREA

Height: 6-8' **Spread:** 5-10'

Location: Zone 3, sun, moist, well-drained

soil.

Shape: Erect, spreading

Foliage: Deep green, fern-like

Notes: Multi-stemmed with foliage similar to a mountain ash; dark green in color. Large white panicle flowers in early summer. Has no known serious disease or pest problems and should be pruned in late winter to early spring.



SEM

Height: 4' Spread: 4'

Location: Zone 3, sun to part shade,

well-drained soil.

Shape: Dwarf form

Foliage: Pinkish-red, fern-like

Notes: Pinkish-red, fern-like spring foliage unfurls along deep pink stems. In summer the neat, round shrub covers itself with creamy white blossoms. Compact, better-branched, and more dense than others, it creates a tight, bushy little mound in the garden, making a fine low hedge or accent planting or shrub border.
