## **CRISPA CUTLEAF**

**Height:** 1-2' **Spread:** 3-6'

**Location:** Zone 3, best in light shade.

**Shape:** Low mounded, dense, compact.

Foliage: Reddish-bronze to green

**Notes:** Maple-like, deeply incised, bright green leaves turn yellow and orange in autumn. Foliage and arching habit are perhaps the best ornamental features of this shrub. Tiny, starshaped, yellowish-white flowers appear in loose clusters late spring. Flowers are rather attractive on close inspection, but not particularly showy from a distance.
