CHERRY TREES

Prunus

Mesabi

Long stemmed, red-fleshed fruits with sugar content halfway between pie cherries and Bing cherries. Pyramidal tree grows to a height of 12 feet. Fruit resembles Meteor but pit is smaller. Blooms in early May.



North Star

A delightful tart cherry that was introduced by the University of Minnesota in 1950. It is extremely hardy and self-pollinating. This cherry is a genetic dwarf that usually only grows 6'-10' tall. Its short height makes it a favored cultivar to the home gardener as it is easy to reach the fruit for harvesting.
