Snow Sweet

Snowsweet is a new apple from the University of Minnesota! The sweet and tart flavor is outstanding. Really crisp and juicy. Fruits are large and reddish-bronze. Flesh is very white and slow to oxidize when exposed to air. Very hardy. Ripens mid to late September.



Sweet Sixteen

One of the best for fresh-off-the-tree eating, Sweet Sixteen is super sweet with a richly complex flavor—similar to vanilla with just a hint of molasses and fine bourbon. A taste treat like no other! Extra hardy and long-lived even in harsh conditions. Ripens mid Sept.



Winecrisp™

A sweet, juicy and firm apple, ideal for baking. Resistance to diseases and fruit drop ensures a reliable, heavy crop every year. Stores up to nine months. Ripens in mid October.



Zestar!®

Zestar! is an early season apple with excellent, dessert quality. It is very crisp and juicy with an above average sweet/tart flavor. This apple is 60-85% red on a yellow background. It will store well for several weeks after being picked in late August in the midwest.
